# 2009 Wheat Shootout

## Aiming High for Minnesota Wheat PAC

at Thief River Falls Sporting Clay Course • Northwest Sporting Clay Association

**Who:** Producers and industry representatives that are interested in having a fun afternoon, with about 50 wheat growers from the region, while shooting clay pigeons and getting to know each other. Experts, novices and beginners are all welcome! If you don't have a shotgun but would like to participate, just let us know.

**What:** 2009 Minnesota Wheat Shootout participants, hosted by the Minnesota Association of Wheat Growers, will be treated to an afternoon of fun, food and entertainment, with each person shooting at over 50 clay pigeons from 10 different stations. There will be contests and awards that will make the day a memorable one. It's a great way to have fun, network with people, and to get some shooting practice in before the fall hunting season.

**Where:** The 2009 Wheat Shootout will take place at the Northwest Sporting Clay Association in Thief River Falls, Minnesota. The course is along the sand ridge north and west of Thief

River Falls. It offers stations that are in mature stands of oak trees and along rolling slopes of the sand ridge as well as in a converted gravel pit. There are also a couple of open field stations that will get you ready for upland game hunting. Northwest Sporting Clay Association Course has 10 different stations including: Right to Left Crossing, Left to Right Crossing, Rabbit and Bird Mini's, Going Away, Coming at You, and closed woodland, and open fields.

**Location:** 3 miles north of Thief River Falls on Hwy 59 then 1.5 miles West. (Roads will be marked).
